Participation format: On-site (as a presenter at plenary and/or sectional sessions) or online via the ZOOM platform.

Application for participation: Registration for the conference is open until November 4, 2023. Participants should send the participant registration form (Appendix № 1) and materials for presentations in the sections for the collection before November 12, 2023, indicating "International Conference" in the email subject line. #### **Requirements for Formatting Materials (Appendix #2).**

–Length: 3 to 5 pages.

–Software: Microsoft Word 2003 or later.

–Page layout: Top margin - 2 cm, bottom margin - 2 cm, left margin - 3 cm, right margin - 1.5 cm.

–Font: Times New Roman, KZ Times New Roman; font size - 14 pt.

–Line spacing: Single; paragraph indentation - 1 cm; portrait orientation; no headers or page numbers; text justified.

–Formulas and symbols should be included in the article text using the Microsoft Equation Editor. Images (jpg, tif, 300 dpi; 600 dpi for bitmap images) and tables should be integrated into the article text with references in the text to figures and tables.

–References to primary sources in the text should be enclosed in square brackets, indicating the source number from the list of references and page numbers when quoting. The reference list (formatted according to GOST 7.1-2003) should be placed at the end of the article.

–The article must include the phrase "The article is being published for the first time," and only articles not previously published in other publications will be accepted.

**Official Publications:** The official publications of the Conference include the Conference Program and the Conference Proceedings. The best presentations will be published in the KazNU Bulletin, Geography Series. Conference materials will be published in electronic format and sent to all participants.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to reject presentations submitted outside the main directions of the conference and to publish abstracts that do not meet the above-mentioned requirements. The text should be edited for style and technical correctness. The Organizing Committee does not intend to edit the content of the materials. ***One and the same individual cannot be the author or co-author of more than three presentations.***

**Registration Fee:** A registration fee is required for participation in the conference, aimed at covering the expenses for the preparation and organization of the event. The fee for one application with up to 5 authors is 5,000 Tenge.
